For the Goddess

This is an unabridged reproduction of the original manuscript of the warlock Fenris Moordragon as discovered by Lord Francis Ravenloch in 1750 during excavations of the ruins of the village of Mithewinter which was razed by witch-hunters in 1645.

The grimoire remained with Lord Ravenloch until his mysterious death in 1815 when it was purchased from the family by Elric Blackmoor, a well known collector of arcane occult literature. It remained in his possession until it was stolen from his rare books library in 1847.

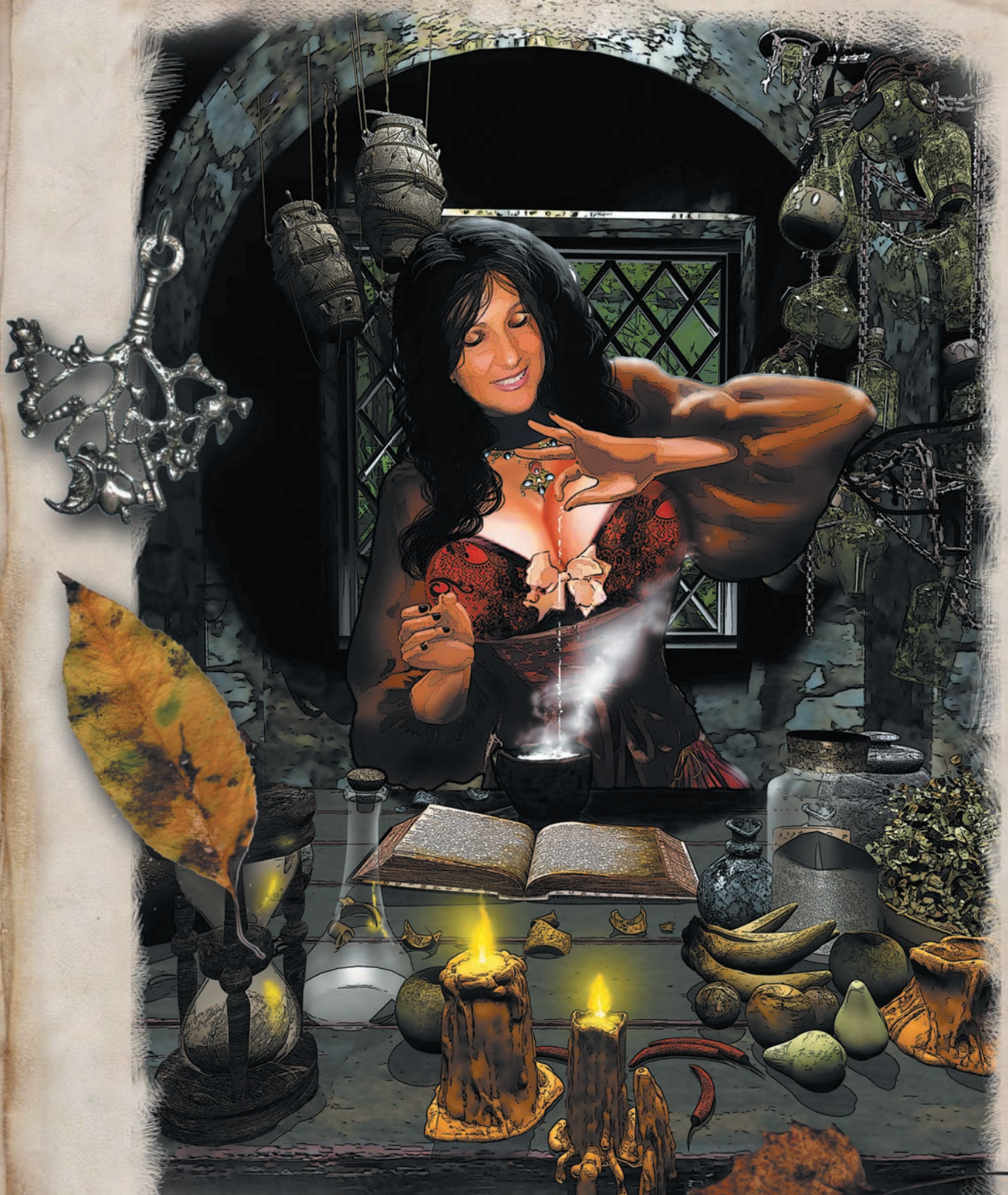
The thief was never caught and the grimoire remained missing for the next 168 years until it appeared sealed in a wooden box sitting in a field on the very spot where Fenris Moordragon's house originally once stood.
